- 1 Kuching City Tour** **Duration: 3-4 hours**

It's the best introduction tour that will give you an overall idea about Borneo as Kuching is the ideal gateway to this Mystical Land of Hidden Paradise. The tour will give you a recap of the history starting before and after the White Rajah Era. Frequent stops are made at some of the most photographed sites for you to bring back some lasting memory of this beautiful Cat City. By the end of this tour, you will definitely be impressed by this Old but Modern and green city. Visit also the viewing platform at the top of the futuristic Civic Centre Tower offer the best all around views of Kuching and the surrounding area. Other places of interest include the famous landmark of the city, The Cat Monument. Pass by market, Main Bazaar, China town, Old State Mosque, Tua Pek Kong Temple & etc. Visit also the most popular meeting place in the city Kuching Waterfront, Taman Sahabat (Malaysia & China Friendship Garden) and the Sarawak Museum. In this Museum grounds there is the Botanical gardens and the Heroes' Memorial, built to commemorate the dead of WWII, the Communist Insurgency and Confrontation with Indonesia. You can choose to do it by walking around as you can blend in with the locals easier.
- 2 Semenggoh Orang Utan Rehabilitation Center + Pottery Shop** **Duration : 3-4 hours**

Located 30 minutes drive from Kuching and another 15 minutes on foot. It is a wildlife sanctuary and a forest reserve for various types of exotic animals and plants of Borneo and the best place in Sarawak to almost guarantee the sighting of Orang Utan – the Wild Man of the Jungle. One of the most heart warming sights is when you witness an Orang Utan mother with young baby which normally roam freely in the rainforest return to the center at feeding time. You can choose to walk through one of the forest walks.
- 3 Bidayuh Longhouse** **Duration : 4 hours**

Located 45 minutes drive from Kuching, it is a large and well preserved traditional Bidayuh – the Land Dayaks longhouse still very much in its pristine architectural feature since the Brookes' era. It is a village cluster of individual 70 – 100 stilted houses that were built very close to each other, displaying a warfare strategy of a strong force to defend attacks from enemy by its hill slope location. Visitors are introduced to their culture while the villagers still carry out their daily work in traditional lifestyle.
- 4 Sarawak Cultural Village + Cat Museum** **Duration : 5 hours**

Located at the scenic foothill of Mt. Santubong, 45 min drive from Kuching city center. This is a Living Museum of Sarawak. It is a summary of the multi-culture of Sarawak's 27 ethnic tribes. An opportunity to witness the 7 major ethnic group who stay in their typical traditional houses and try out their daily work. It is a popular shooting site for international film crew especially with the natives who are dressed in their traditional colourful costume. Tour will end with a cultural show. En-route back visit to Cat Museum.
- 5 Jong's Crocodile Farm & Mini Zoo** **Duration : 3-4 hours**

Located about 25km from Kuching, this privately-owned crocodile farm is the largest of its kind in Sarawak. Spread over an area of three and a half acres of land, it houses over 1000 crocodiles. Visitors can see crocodiles being fed and learn all about their life cycle. There are other exotic animals and a mini aviary where you are allowed to walk through for a close encounter with some of the beautiful birds. It is a paradise for children and will definitely become their memorable visit. You can consider ending the crocodile in your stomach at the eatery where crocodile soup is served.
- 6 Fairy & Wind Cave & Bau – Gold Town** **Duration : 4 hours**

Located 70 km from Kuching, Bau is a former major gold mining town and the famous headquarter of the Chinese Rebellion of 1858. It is also well known for its limestone caves that have generated many bird nests and legends. It is a great soft adventure to explore the 2 caves that is full of spectacular natural limestone sculptures. Especially in Fairy Cave where some are figurine look-a-like stalagmites that resemble the Chinese legendary god and Goddesses e.g. Kwan Yin, the Chinese Goddess of Mercy. It was a location in the filming of the Hollywood movie Farewell to the King. You can enjoy a picnic lunch or a cool dip at mouth of the subterranean stream that run through the Wind Cave or blend in with the locals at "Kopitiam" or local café for some local specialty dishes. There are other sections of the caves catering for more adventurous caving and rock climbing activities e.g. the Batman's Wall.

7 Sarawak River Cruise

Duration : 1.5 hrs

This cruise will complement the Kuching city tour especially when it become a very romantic ride if you can catch a glimpse of the world most beautiful sunset while sailing along this tranquil river on a clear late afternoon. Party or special themed dinner can be arranged on board with some other entertainment programme and facilities e.g. Karaoke, PA system.

8 Borneo Highland Resort / Hornbill Golf & Jungle Club

Duration : Daytrip/Overnight

Drive through the world's second largest and oldest lush virgin rain forest of Penrissen Mountain Range of 1,000 meters above the sea-level, 70km away from the Kuching. This is the Sarawak's only mountain resort - the RM500 million self-contained and golf course. Kalimantan Border, Flower Garden, Rose Garden, Vertical Garden, Swan Lake, Rabbits Park, Rock Art, Organic Farm, Horticulture Nursery and Kalimantan Border. Take a breather at the Chinese Tea House to enjoy the refreshing local organic tea. Stay longer for a relaxing experience to enjoy the heavenly pampering provided by the skillful masseurs with the state of art spa facilities or go for one round of golf game on the organic grass and stay overnight in their naturally air-conditioned room. Their policy of serving only vegetarian specialties culinary is worth following to cleanse your digestive system.

9 Gunung Gading National Park

Duration: Day Trip

Located 2 hours drive from Kuching, it is a main conservation area for the Rafflesia, the world's largest flower, which can grow up to one meter in diameter and Amorphillus, world's largest flower on a single stem. The park also offers a number of attractive walking trails, leading through primary rainforest and some of the most beautiful waterfalls. It was a favourite spot for our White Rajah family to invite their visitors for an outing. You can enjoy a picnic lunch then a cool dip at one of the spectacular waterfall.

Overnight accommodation can be arranged at the park's chalets or lodges.

10 Bako National Park

Duration : Day Trip

It takes ½ hour drive from Kuching and another 30 minutes boat ride out to South China Sea to reach this small peninsula. It is a botanical treasure with as many as 25 different types of vegetation and 7 distinct rainforest eco systems with vast diversity of animal and plant life. Exotic animals e.g. bizarre proboscis monkeys, silvered Langurs (leaf monkeys), flying Lemur and squirrels, monitor lizard, the messy unshaven Bearded wild boar, long tailed macaques, sambar dears numerous species of birds and snakes. It's a great adventure into the mother nature where some of the trail can really put your physical fitness to test as it lead you to up rugged hilltop. Enjoy a picnic lunch on a spectacular spot overlooking one of the best-secluded beach. Overnight accommodation can be arranged at the park's chalets or lodges.

This tour is not feasible during our monsoon season (Nov-Mar) due to rough sea condition.

11 2 Days 1 Nights The Headhunter's (Iban) Longhouse

Duration : Overnight

This tour will bring you to venture deep into the heart of Borneo to blend in with the fearless warriors to experience their simple lifestyle and their legendary hospitality.

This exciting experience start with 270km of overland journey and continue with a 45 minutes longboat ride shooting the rapids upriver to reach a pristine Iban longhouse along the riverbank. Their Madame and warriors clad in their traditional costume will perform Ngajat – their traditional dance and serve you Tuak - their special rice brewed wine to welcome your arrival. Try their Blow Pipe - traditional hunting gear and weapon and enjoy a demo of their cock fighting game. You can opt to rush back to Kuching Or stay for a night at their guest house build next to their longhouse complete with basic facilities. This will allow more time for you to enjoy a leisure bath in the river (or the mountain water in the bath room for the less adventurous) and socialize with them in the evening as they invite you to join them for some traditional games. Join them in the morning for a walk through their farm. For the faint hearted, you can reside in the comfort of the luxurious Batang Ai Longhouse Resort which is 45 minutes from the authentic longhouse.
